



Shikhya/MoSchooL Program Donor Communication

A Quick Recap

Hope you are doing well. We wanted to give you an update on the **Shikhya & MoSchool Initiative** that we discussed at the **IASF 2020 Valentine Day Event**. At the event we had announced that for \$250, we would have a school sponsored for the Shikhya curriculum using the Moschool Matching program. The plan was as follows:

\$250 from the donor will be matched by corporate donations(whenever possible). Then with the 2X match from the MoSchool Program in Odisha, we will have sufficient funds to support Shikhya curriculum at a specific school of your choice. At some point we had also identified the schools and students at those schools who would have benefited from the program.

The Shikhya curriculum required certain hardware to be purchased, fees to be paid to operational staff at this Shikhya institute and fees for the online curriculum. The funding plan described above was enough to cover these expenses. The following table shows the donors, their pledges and the status of our collection.

Soon after the 2020 Valentines Day event COVID struck. Everything shut down and so did our collection efforts against the pledges. We decided that till we have an execution program in place, we would not go back to the donors to collect the pledged amounts.

MoSchool Program and IASF

During COVID, we continued to work with the governmental body in Odisha for the MoSchool program. We ran into a couple of issues.

1. The MoSchool Program worked directly with a school vs. the modus operandi we had planned. For us to collect funds for multiple schools and then collect the matching funds did not align with the program structure from the government.
2. The MoSchool organization still doesn't have FCRA certification which is necessary for it to be able to receive funds from overseas. This prevents IASF from sending funds to Mo School. We are monitoring this situation and plan to reengage with MoSchool when they obtain FCRA certification.

Launching of IASF Shikhya Online

We changed course and came up with a different approach that the situations warranted. During COVID, students could not go to school. In partnership with Shikhya, we launched an online education program which has been working really well. We worked with Biswajit Nayak(CEO and Founder of Shikhya) to identify students who met the following criteria

- Needy - Needed financial assistance with the Shikhya Online fees
- Had shown desire to learn in an online program
- Had access to smart devices

As a pilot program, we identified 100 such students from various schools across Odisha, negotiated the per student rate with Shikhya(a significant discount on their fees) and launched what we called IASF Shikhya Online. See below for a snapshot of the dashboard that shows the progress report of the students. This dashboard shows:

- The specific students benefited by the Donor
- Skills mastered by the student
- Skills struggled by the student

- Exercises Completed
- School Progress Report

Donors can access this dashboard themselves and see the progress regularly, if they want to. If desired, the donors can also request to speak to any of the students they have sponsored directly.
